Information Pack for Food Vendors

Essential information

IMPORTANT: PLEASE ENSURE NECESSARY PROTECTION IS IN PLACE FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE ATTENDEES AND VENDORS (e.g. barrier for hot surfaces)

Table Size: 2.4 meters x 0.6 meters

Table Covers: 1 table cover provided by the DIA

Number of tables: 1 table will be provided by DIA.

Table Configuration: You can bring one more table: We will provide one table for display and your

table can be for storage.

Disposables, Cutlery, Water Bottles: To be provided by the food vendor

Power Supply: Standard power outlets will be provided.

Electrical equipment: Ensure equipment is tagged to ensure safety

Heating/Warming Equipment: Only low-power equipment is permitted.

Food and beverage: Both vegetarian and non-vegetarian options are acceptable, but beef and

pork are not permitted. Only non-alcoholic beverage is allowed.

Food License: A food license must be displayed or kept on hand.

Gas tank: Gas tanks or burners are not permitted.

Payment: No EFTPOS provided by DIA. Vendors must provide a means of payment (cash or

contactless payment via phone).

Internet: Wi-Fi will be available.

Food Safety: Adherence to food safety guidelines is mandatory. (visit Diwali Website).

H&S briefing: H&S briefing will occur at **2:15 PM** at the venue. Please make sure you are available

for this.

Food license: Food License must be displayed on the food counter.

Essential Tips:

- **Branding:** Display your company banner prominently to attract attention and create a professional impression.
- **Menu and Pricing:** Present your menu and price list in an easy-to-read format. Consider using digital displays or large, clear signs.
- Cash Handling: Ensure you have adequate change on hand to facilitate smooth cash transactions.



- **Allergy Information:** Provide clear information about potential allergens in your food, such as peanuts, gluten, or dairy.
- **Take-Home Materials:** Offer flyers or menus for attendees to take with them, promoting your business and making it easier for them to remember your offerings.

Additional Tips:

- Sample Offerings: Consider providing small samples of your food to entice potential customers.
- **Efficient Service:** Aim for quick and efficient service to minimise wait times and keep customers satisfied.
- **Staff Training:** Ensure your staff is well-trained and knowledgeable about your products, allergens, and payment options.
